



Guidance Counselor Information Sheet

What are the minimum requirements for admission?

All applications are reviewed for admissions based on a number of factors including but not limited to grade point average, rigor of course work, official test scores and community and school involvement.

The minimum requirement needed for acceptance is at least a 2.5 GPA and, if applicable, at least a 900 on the SAT and at least a 19 on the ACT. These scores do not in any way guarantee acceptance, nor are they absolute minimums, they are simply guidelines.

How long does it take to get an admissions decision?

Once an admissions file is complete it takes 7-10 business days to be notified of a decision. A “complete file” includes a high school transcript and official test scores (for freshman applicants) and transcripts from ALL INSTITUTIONS ATTENDED SINCE HIGH SCHOOL and test scores (if required for transfer students). Each file is unique and may require additional credentials.

What are the application deadlines?

Brenau operates on rolling admissions. Students can apply throughout the year. Keep in mind that it generally takes at least a week to complete and decision a file. Students need to allow enough time to complete this process prior the beginning of the semester in which they intend to enroll.

Do you offer any academic scholarships?

Brenau evaluates all Women’s College applications for academic scholarship based on GPA and test scores. There is no additional application necessary. Students will be notified if they have received a scholarship when they receive their acceptance letter. For applicants to the nursing and occupational therapy departments students will receive their scholarship award, if any, when they are accepted to the program.

How should I submit a transcript for my student?

High school guidance counselors can fax or email high school transcripts and SAT/ACT scores to the Office of Admissions at 770.538.4701 or admissions@brenau.edu. However, the final high school transcripts must be mailed in an official envelope by the school.

What type of high school diploma does Brenau require for admission?

Brenau requires that students complete a college preparatory curriculum with the successful completion of:

- ◆ 4 units English
- ◆ 4 units Math/Science
- ◆ 3 units Social Studies
- ◆ 2 units Foreign Language
