RECOMMENDED IMMUNIZATIONS

MENINGOCOCCAL: College freshmen who live in dorms are five times more likely to be infected with meningococcal disease compared to others the same age. Of those who contract meningococcal disease, 10% to 15% die and 11% to 19% suffer mental retardation, hearing loss, seizures, strokes or the loss of arms or legs. All Georgia colleges require students living in dorms to document they have been vaccinated or that they have reviewed information about meningococcal disease. **Student's initials indicating that they have read this statement are required:** _____

HUMAN PAPILLOMAS VIRUS (HPV): HPV can cause cervical cancer in females and other forms of cancer or genital warts in both females and males. Each year 6.2 million people get new HPV infections, eighty percent of sexually active women will have HPV by the age of 50, the vaccine is close to 100% effective, and it is one of the few ways to prevent a type of cancer. (3 doses for female college students 11-26 years of age at 0, 2, and 6 month intervals.)

INFLUENZA: Influenza can lead to pneumonia and death. Annual immunization is recommended to avoid disruption to academic activities and health sciences students with patient contact.

HEPATITIS A: A highly contagious viral infection of the liver and is recommended for people with risk conditions such as clotting disorders, drug users, and people with chronic liver disease including Hepatitis C. Two doses: second doses six to 12 months after first dose.
