

MBA in Healthcare Management

The MBA in Healthcare Management provides graduates with comprehensive knowledge of leadership and management principles in an increasingly competitive healthcare environment. The Healthcare Management MBA is a 13 course, 39 credit hour degree program which leads to a Masters of Business Administration degree and a certificate in Healthcare Management. Students can begin the program at any time during the year, and can complete the program entirely online or in a combination of online and on-ground courses lasting seven weeks.

Graduates of the program will be able to apply management tools and techniques relative to achieving organizational goals and objectives; identify strengths and weaknesses in individual leadership skills; apply decision-making models and systematic problem-solving methods to enhance and improve individual and organizational performance; apply critical thinking skills to real-world strategies in the healthcare industry; and develop networking skills to enhance the potential for individual growth.

The Healthcare Management MBA is well-suited for clinical professionals, such as RNs, Medical Technologists, and other medical specialists, to expand their potential for promotion and leadership responsibility.

Brenau also offers the option to students who already hold a graduate degree to earn the **Healthcare Management Certificate** by completing the 5 required courses in the Healthcare Management Concentration curriculum.

Curriculum

Preparatory Courses

To enhance their success in the program, students are required to take BA 500 MBA Foundations (6 hours) unless they have an undergraduate business degree from a regionally accredited institution within the last 7 years. In addition, BA507 Introduction to Business Communications (3 hours) is required for all MBA applicants that enter the program with only an undergraduate degree. The course may be waived if the applicant has a prior masters degree.

2012-13 tuition is calculated at \$540 per credit. There is a \$260 per semester fee for technology. Thus the total cost for an MBA at Brenau University is approximately \$21,000.
